So how does a person get a re-made heart?

- A. Be cautious about potential “Man-made” Heart Transplants:
1. Religious zealousness.
 2. Legalism.
 3. Extensive knowledge of the Bible and/or long-term church attendance.
 4. A warm, enjoyable supernatural experience.
- B. Admit you need a new heart in the first place. Matthew 13:15
- C. Believe that Jesus died and rose from the dead to pay for your selfishness/your sin. Romans 10:9-11, John 1:12

Digging Deeper This Week

- Monday:** Read Ephesians 1:15-23. Identify and ponder some of the specific things Paul prayed we might have out hearts enlightened about.
- Tuesday:** Read Mark 12:30-31. Think about areas where you need to “love God” more particularly with your soul, mind and strength.
- Wednesday:** Read Proverbs 4. Focusing on v. 23, ask God to show you areas where you particularly need to “guard your heart” more carefully.
- Thursday:** Re-read Romans 10:9-10. Recall and thank God for the time when you finally believed and confessed, choosing to become a child of God.
- Friday:** Meditate on Hebrews 4:12. Commit today to start or continue to dig into God’s Word more deeply as another way to keep your heart strong and pure.
